



TOOTH ERUPTION: FROM NORMAL TO ABNORMAL FROM THEORY TO CLINICAL PRACTICE PART II

Abstract

The course on teeth eruption patterns will cover normal and abnormal teeth eruption, clinical signs and differential diagnosis as well as possible treatment options throughout all dentition stages: from early mixed until permanent dentition.

We will cover all aspects of most prevalent canine impactions - both palatal and labial as well as not that frequent but important eruption disturbances of first permanent molar, incisors and bicuspid. All problem-solving clinical settings will be covered from wait and see to the exposure and forced eruption from Mini screws.

The course will be fully covered by clinical examples and real patients' stories. The course will be conducted in English.

Course Curriculum

- Labially impacted canines: diagnostic and treatment objectives. Clinical management.
- First permanent molars: ectopic eruption, impaction, primary eruption failure.
- Impacted premolars - can they really be called impacted?
